# Scope:

Articles which contribute to the ongoing dialogue in the respective and related fields of study are welcomed and published in the spirit of knowledge dissemination that promotes intellectual exchange and enhances global socio-cultural understanding through a deep engagement with literature, culture, history and the arts.
- 3. **Comparative and Cross-Cultural Studies:** *Gitanjali and Beyond* is dedicated to fostering cross-cultural understanding and comparative perspectives. We invite submissions that explore the commonalities and differences among cultures, languages, and historical contexts, thus promoting a global dialogue that can only promote mutual respect and mutual understanding as initiated by Tagore and his associates.
